

Exploring *Hampshire*

Whether you're a history buff, nature lover or vintage car aficionado, there is something for all ages in this glorious 'Garden County', on Tylney Hall's doorstep...





Tylney Hall Hotel is such a serene spot that many guests are content to stray no further than the house, wellness facilities and gardens... and seriously, who can blame them?

That said, the surrounding Hampshire countryside is so rich in culture and history, that it would be a crying shame not to take in a few of the sites. Here are a few of our favourite attractions.

1. Highclere Castle

Ever wanted to have a nosy at Downton Abbey up close? Highclere Castle is the breathtaking setting of the hit TV series. Situated in 5,000 acres of parkland, designed by the legendary Capability Brown, it is also the official seat of the Earl of Carnarvon. Highlights include The Secret Garden and opulent staterooms. 🚗 35 minute drive

2. Jane Austen's House Museum

Jane Austen spent the last eight years of her life in a peaceful red brick cottage in the village of Chawton. Now a museum, you can see the little writing table where she penned immortal works such as *Pride and Prejudice*, and explore the wildflower garden that she once strolled in. 🚗 28 minute drive

3. Marwell Zoo

Looking for a fun family day out? This thrilling 140-acre zoo is home to over 135 species including zebras, giraffes, tigers, penguins, white rhinos and endangered animals. You can also take a ride on a toy train and explore the brand new Tropical House, whilst children have no less than five adventure playgrounds to explore. 🚗 43 minute drive

4. Winchester Cathedral

One of the largest in Europe, Winchester Cathedral is a medieval Gothic wonder. It is worth seeing for the awe-inspiring vaulted ceiling alone, but other notable features include the Norman crypt, 17th century Morley Library and St. Nicholas carvings. It is also where Jane Austen was laid to rest. 🚗 38 minute drive



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

5. National Motor Museum, Beaulieu

This is definitely one for the vintage transport fans. Tucked away in heart of the New Forest, this fascinating museum houses over 250 vehicles as well as the ‘World of Top Gear’ exhibition. Highlights include an original 19th century Benz and a fleet of racing cars. As a bonus, every ticket will also give you access to Beaulieu Abbey and Palace House.

🚗 60 minute drive

6. Exbury Gardens

Ever taken a steam train ride through a storybook garden? Now is your chance. Exbury offers an abundance of woodlands, grounds and floral features to explore, including the Daffodil Meadow, Rock Garden and Herbaceous Garden. A heavenly hideaway lining the Beaulieu River, these exquisite gardens offer a view all the way to the Isle of Wight.

🚗 60 minute drive

7. The Vyne

Set in 1,500 acres of ancient woodlands and wetlands, this 16th century Tudor house boasts an ornamental lake and stained glass chapel. Visitors are even given the chance to dress up in Victorian costume. After your tour of the house, gardens and lime avenue, you can stop off for scones in the Brewhouse tearoom.

🚗 20 minute drive

8. New Forest Wildlife Park

Otters, lynxes and wolves are just some of the fascinating creatures inhabiting this amazing wildlife park. Based on the edge of the New Forest, you will also find a Wallaby Wood, red deer enclosure and owlery. Younger nature lovers can make the most of the adventure playgrounds and pirate boats.

🚗 50 minute drive

9. The Royal Navy Submarine Museum

Based on the waterfront at Gosport, this maritime museum offers a guided tour of the HMS Alliance, the only surviving WWII submarine. You will have a chance to peek through the submarine’s original periscope and hear stories about the wartime crew. This is an amazing slice of naval history that you won’t find anywhere else.

🚗 75 minute drive

10. Birdworld

Britain’s largest bird park, Birdworld devotes 26 acres to celebrating our feathered friends. Highlights include Penguin Island, Flamingo Cove and the Jenny Wren Farm, as well as freeflying parrots. Marine life even gets a look in too at the Underwater World aquarium.

🚗 28 minute drive

Afternoon Tea with the Experts...

Afternoon Tea has long been a British tradition, dating back to the 1840's and shows no sign of slowing down. But how do we know that we are making the most of our Afternoon Tea? Is there a perfect blend to match with the perfect scone?

We went straight to the experts at Birchall Tea, proud suppliers of tea to Elite Hotels, to help us discover the perfect pairings and find out the secret to making the most of your Afternoon Tea.

Firstly, could you explain a bit about Birchall Tea?

Birchall Tea is a fifth-generation independent tea company based in London. Our roots in the trade date back over 140 years to when Captain Birchall Graham — the first active member of our family in the tea trade — cultivated tea in Darjeeling. We remain family run to this day and are thrilled to supply tea across the UK and beyond.

Why do you think tea is the perfect drink to accompany Afternoon Tea?

Tea has been the integral part of Afternoon Tea in Britain since the 1800's — as Jane Austen once wrote, "But indeed I would rather have nothing but tea"! Tea was originally introduced to the Royal Courts and the habit was adopted by the aristocracy. It's the perfect drink because of this longstanding tradition, as well as the intricate flavours of each type of tea that perfectly accompany the food served. We have been proud to work with Elite hotels since 2016.

Which flavours would you recommend to complement each tier of a traditional Afternoon Tea?

Tier 1 Sandwiches Strong flavours would suit a traditional sandwich selection. Our black teas — Great Rift Breakfast Blend or our Darjeeling — would accompany these very well indeed.

Tier 2 Freshly baked warm scones Here I would recommend pairing fruity scones with fruity/floral notes. For example, the bergamot in our Virunga Earl Grey would be a perfect fit here. Other options would be a Red Berry & Flower, a Green Tea & Peach or a Jasmine Tea Pearl.

Tier 3 Patisserie Eclairs, tarts and general sweet treats — With sweet treats, I would recommend pairing light liquoring teas — for example our Virunga Afternoon Tea and our classic Green Tea.



What in your opinion makes the perfect cup of tea?

With over 45 Gold Stars won across our range at the Great Taste Awards, you're asking the right people! For the tea itself, it's the provenance, freshness and the flavour. For example, our expert tea tasters source our English Breakfast blend by tasting up to 3000 East African teas each week to ensure the very best flavour. We always recommend our teas to be served in loose leaf format — something that Elite Hotels do expertly. The perfect cup of tea is also aided by the setting and the people / lack of people around you!

Let us in on the secret, how long should we be leaving our cup of tea to brew to get the perfect cup?

It completely depends on the type of tea/herbal infusion. For our Black Teas, we recommend just a couple of minutes, and our herbal infusions can be brewed for as long as you like — the longer you leave it, the more strength and flavour there will be.

What do Birchall's find is the most popular flavour of tea?

At home, by far and away the most popular tea is the classic, English

Breakfast tea. However, when taking Afternoon Tea, we find that customers increasingly prefer to try something a little different than what they are used to so for example, an Earl Grey, a Darjeeling or a Green Tea.

Finally, are there any tea trends that you have noticed? Any teas you see being big news in the upcoming year?

In recent years we have seen a rise in popularity of healthy teas and herbal infusions. Green Teas are a fantastic idea if you're looking for a tea with antioxidants. We offer a lovely Green Tea & Peach if you're not so keen on a pure green tea taste. We've also seen a rise in naturally caffeine free herbal infusions. Products such as Redbush (or Rooibos) are caffeine free but also packed with antioxidants.

Work is underway to fully refurbish over 70 bedrooms and suites across the group, providing a fresh new look with luxurious finishing touches. Summer 2019 saw each of our terrace dining areas benefit from new furnishings, perfect for catching that seasonal sun with a light meal or drink.

Ashdown Park have already begun work on an 18-month plan to refresh the Country Club facilities, with the new-look pool (pictured) open for business. Once complete, The Country Club will boast new changing rooms, gymnasium, relaxation area and an expanded Fairway Lounge.

A separate project to upgrade a series of meeting and private dining rooms will commence later this year.

Tylney Hall have submitted a planning application for a redesigned Health Suite and expansion of the Chestnut Suite. Conversion of the Hampshire Suite into a second eatery with brasserie style dining is planned for the autumn.

The Grand Hotel's Cocktail Bar and Great Hall will be transformed towards the end of 2019, with further plans to refresh the Health Suite and a series of meeting private dining rooms.

Following completion of the 19th Bar, Luton Hoo will soon begin work on refurbishing the Adam's Bar as well as the Capability Brown and Churchill function spaces.



Claude Debussy

A brief look back at the fascinating musical history of The Grand Hotel

Dominating the shoreline with its grand stature, this magnificent 19th century hotel has been an iconic landmark on the seafront and has an abundance of musical heritage which seeps through the buildings history.

The Great Hall has been described as the central musical hub of The Grand since the early 1900's and has housed some iconic moments. It is here that the first hotel Orchestra played in 1903 and

offered daily musical entertainment, led by Mr Von Leer and his 4 piece Palm Court String up until 1905. It is also here where from 1924 – 1939 the BBC published a live weekly broadcast each Sunday evening, as the acoustics were (and are today) said to be one of the best.

A famous face to frequent Eastbourne and The Grand hotel was Claude Debussy, who arrived in 1905 along with his pregnant Mistress Emma Bardac. It would be in the

Grand, on the 2nd Floor (Debussy Suite – Room 200) where he completed 'La Mer', which at the time was not a critical success but has since gone on to become one of his most well-known pieces.

Today the musical influence at The Grand still lives on with events including: The Pasadena Roof Orchestra, Palm Court Strings, Damian Montagu and Stuart Prosser as well as other musical acts which are always hugely popular.
